EFW is funded solely through voluntary contributions. The trust balance is now over \$280,000 and we were able to increase the number of the scholarships this year.

The earnings and new contributions fund the yearly scholarship disbursements.

The administrative expenses are very low and are less than 0.03% of the trust balance.
