**MISSION:**

To promote the ethical practice of Professional Engineering.

**OBJECTIVES:**

**Education:** Educate members of the profession, students, and others regarding professional practice and engineering ethics.

**Public Service:** Aid the public in understanding the professional practice of engineering and assist state agencies, licensing boards, local units of government and others in protecting the public health, safety and welfare.

**Investigation:** Investigate alleged professional misconduct complaints and recommend appropriate action.



**ACTIVITIES/PROGRAMS:**

**Education:**

- ❖ Provide speakers and conduct programs for technical, professional, public and other groups.
- ❖ Compile, disseminate, and publish information about ethics and professional practice.

**Public Service:**

- ❖ Create "select committees" to deal with specific issues.
- ❖ Maintain liaison with state agencies involved with engineering.
- ❖ Assist engineering clients with professional practice problems.

**Investigation:**

- ❖ Receive and investigate formal and informal complaints about professional engineers and engineering practice.
- ❖ Develop corrective solutions, and where necessary, recommend sanctions against those violating the code of ethics or the examining board's rules of professional conduct.
