The scholarships are available to graduating high school seniors who plan to study engineering at a four-year ABET accredited program intend to enter the profession of engineering upon graduation. Applicants will be considered for the following scholarships.

- The Engineers Foundation of Wisconsin Scholarship, four **\$3,000** scholarships
- The Louis C. Geiger Scholarship, three **\$3,000** scholarships
- The Harold D. Kobbervig Memorial Scholarship, three to six **\$3,000 to \$5,000** scholarships, limited to high schools in Racine, Kenosha and Walworth Counties
- The Robert G. Cooper Scholarship, one **\$3,000** scholarship
- The Terry Ni Engineering Scholarship <http://www.tnscholarship.org>, one to six scholarships at a minimum of **\$3,000** each

In addition to the State Scholarship Program, several local chapters of the NSPE-WI organization throughout the state also award scholarships to students in their area. They will be using this same application for their selection and awards.
