The Engineers Foundation of Wisconsin, a non-profit foundation of the National Society of Professional Engineers-Wisconsin (NSPE-WI), is pleased to send you information regarding our **Engineering Scholarships**. The scholarships are available to graduating high school seniors who plan to study engineering at a four-year ABET/EAC accredited program leading to a baccalaureate degree in engineering and intend to enter the profession of engineering upon graduation. Applicants will be considered for the following scholarships.

- The Engineers Foundation of Wisconsin Scholarship, four **\$2,500** scholarships
- The WSPE Past Presidents Scholarship, one **\$2,500** scholarship
- The Louis C. Geiger Scholarship, three **\$2,500** scholarships
- The Harold D. Kobbervig Memorial Scholarship, two to five **\$2,500 to \$7,500** scholarships, limited to high schools in Racine, Kenosha and Walworth Counties
- The Terry Ni Engineering Scholarship <http://www.tnscholarship.org>, one to six scholarships at a minimum of **\$3,000** each

In addition to the State Scholarship Program, several local chapters of the NSPE-WI organization throughout the state also award scholarships to students in their area. They will be using this same application for their selection and awards.
